

Supplies required:

- 200 x 300 Hoop
- 2 Pieces of Tear-away Stabilizer
- Painters Tape
- Stapler
- Two straps, either elastic or cotton straps
 - 2 - 7" Elastic or 4 - 16" straps
- 4 - 10" x 10" pieces of fabric of your choice
 - or 2 - 12" x 7" pieces of fabric



Disclaimer: This is not a medical grade face mask and is not meant to replace the surgical face mask. This face mask will not protect against any virus but can aid in preventing the spread of diseases if worn properly. Wearing a DIY face mask is better than nothing at all. Step 1

Hoop Tear-away Stabilizer and place on machine



Step 2

Run placement stitches



Step 3

Lay your fabric over the placement stitches making sure it lays flat and fully covers



Lay fabric over other side.
It can overlap slightly in the middle.



Step 4

Smooth out fabric.
Run the tack-down stitch



Step 5

Next run the logo



Step 6

Lay the strap in the top corner and tape in place. Make sure it covers the line so it will get sewn in. Bring the other end of the strap down to the other corner and make sure covers the bottom line. Tape in place.



Make sure the tape is outside of the stitching areas.

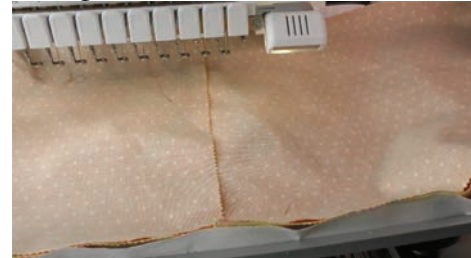
Step 7

Run the tack-down stitch to hold the strap in place. Make sure both sides grab and are sewn down in place



Step 8

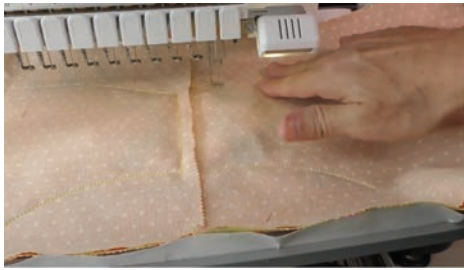
Take your second piece of fabric and place it face down on top of each side. Making sure they lay as flat as possible.



Step 9

Run the next tack-down stitch.

This finishes Part 1. Remove from machine



Part 2 Step 1

Remove from hoop and cut down the middle to separate them

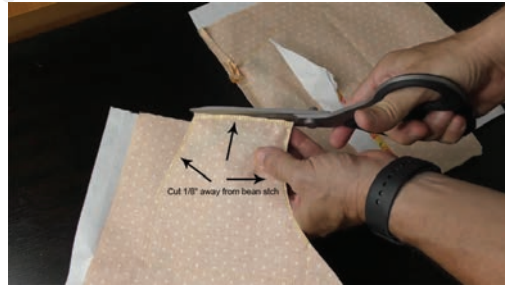


Part 2 Step 2

Cut about 1/8th of an inch away from the bean stitch



Just outside of the "bean stitch"



Cut right along the remaining lines



Cut out the second side the same way

Part 2 Step 3

Remove stabilizer from both sides



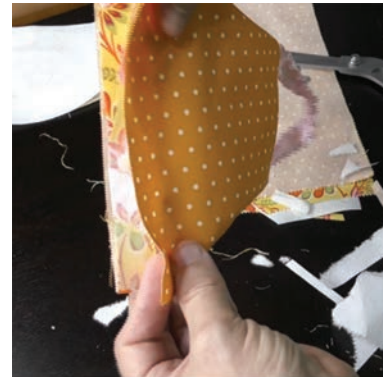
Part 2 Step 4

Turn both pieces inside out.
Finger press the seams



Part 2 Step 5

Line up all 4 pieces exactly together



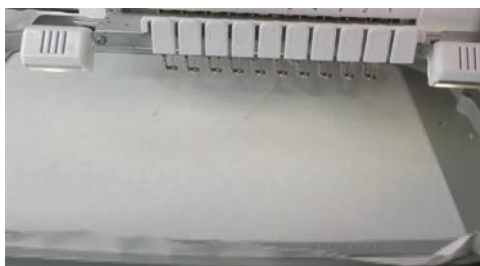
Part 2 Step 6

Staple sides together. Making sure it's all lined up smoothly



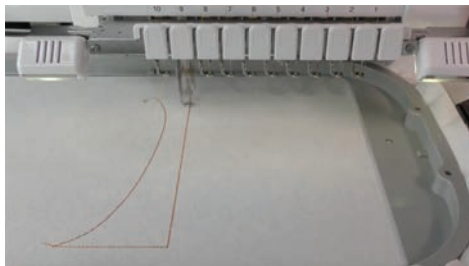
Part 2 Step 7

Hoop second piece of stabilizer



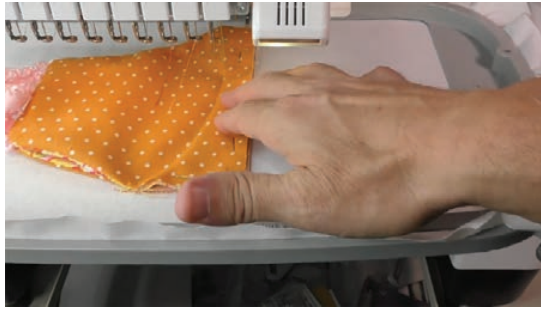
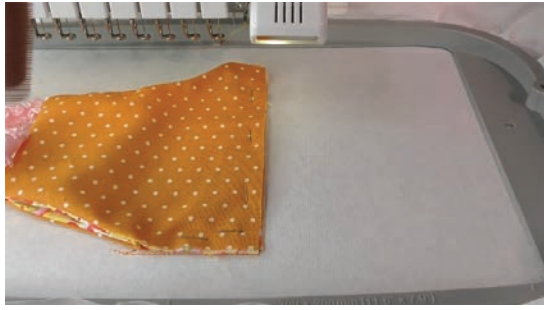
Part 2 Step 8

Run the placement line



Part 2 Step 9

Position the mask in place making sure it's lined up to the guide



Part 2 Step 10

Sew the next tack down stitches



Part 2 Step 11

Remove from stabilizer and cut along edge and turn it inside out
